## Sporting Events

On Thursday 9th May, Mrs Baker took ten Year 3 and Year 4 pupils to a **Kwik Cricket Festival**. Different skills were practised at stations named after famous cricket grounds, as a celebration of the Cricket World Cup. Our children excelled with their bowling, batting and fielding skills were highly praised by staff. The team came away with a first place certificate and badge and should be congratulated for their hard work, their good listening skills and enthusiasm.

## Year 3/4 Tag Rugby

On Wednesday 15th May, nine children from Badger Class took part in the South Norfolk Tag Rugby Festival. In the morning, the children participated in three coaching sessions which were designed to develop a different part of the game. In the afternoon, there was a tournament officiated superbly by the Wymondham College Sports Leaders. The Spooner Row team (including four children playing in their first tournament) played brilliantly winning all of their four games. They scored a total of 25 tries and only conceded 4.

## South Norfolk Tag Rugby Finals

On Wednesday 22nd May, ten children from Oak Class took part in the South Norfolk Tag Rugby Finals at Wymondham RFC. All the teams had qualified for this tournament from their clusters which meant that the standard was very high. The Spooner Row team played brilliantly in the pool stages and won all five games. The semi-final was against a very strong Brooke team. Spooner Row quickly went 2-0 down but pulled back to level the score at 5-5. In the last seconds of the game Spooner Row managed to score a great try to secure the win. The final was against Wymondham Cluster rivals, Wreningham. This was another very close game; the final score was Wreningham 5, Spooner Row 4.

## Badminton

On Monday 13th May, ten children from Badger Class took part in the Racketpack Badminton festival at Wymondham Leisure Centre. The children tried a range of activities designed to develop their individual skills for badminton. They had lots of fun at this non-competitive event which was delivered by Badminton England and supported by the excellent sports leaders from Wymondham High School.
